



Purple Alert guidelines for consent

Involve the person with dementia in all the decision making processes.

Have a conversation with the person with dementia about staying safe.

Consider the best interests of the person with dementia and the least restrictive options.

Does the person with dementia have the capacity to give informed consent?

NO

YES

If the benefits outweigh the levels of risk then the app may still be an option.

Power of Attorney in place.

If no Power of Attorney in place consider seeking legal advice and obtaining Guardianship.

Have a conversation about creating a Purple Alert profile

NO

MAYBE

YES

If consent is withheld then signpost to alternatives.

Consider getting further information and advice. Have a conversation with the person with dementia to unpick concerns.

Create a Purple Alert profile to share on the app if the person with dementia goes missing.
